Notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Access to all buildings whether affected by the shutdown or not will be restricted to security and essential staff only. • No events or work-related activities are to be scheduled during this time. • All building heating, ventilation, air conditioning will be out of service. • Air exchange will be shut off. Air exchange systems will be re-started before regular work hours resume. Please do not attend campus during the shutdown period, unless authorized to do so. • During the shutdown domestic hot water at all faucets etc. will be out of service. • Emergency safety showers and eye-wash will be cold water ONLY • Air conditioning and fan coils that are not on the Essential power grid will be out of service. • Walk-in freezers and coolers that are not on the Essential power grid will be out of service. It is recommended to relocate the product or do not open the door for the duration of the shutdown. • Emergency lighting and life safety systems will NOT be affected as they are powered off the campus Essential Power grid. • All Building elevators will be locked out of service.
